To sing or not to sing in English churches

Government guidance was updated on 14th August and now allows for a small group to sing at the front of church:

"Small groups of professional or non-professional singers will be able to sing in front of worshippers both outdoors and indoors from 15 August. Singing in groups should be limited to a small set group of people and should not include audience (sic) participation".
